Author's

Viewpoint/Perspective- a unique combination of ideas, values, feelings, and beliefs..



Style – the manner in which a work is written. It involves HOW something is said rather than WHAT is said.

Some examples: formal, informal, serious, conversational


Counterarguments- "cases" or arguments made to oppose a view that is different from the author's viewpoint.

Word Choice-use of specific words that helps determine an author's style.



Figurative language – words and phrases used imaginatively in ways that go beyond their literal meanings.

Some examples: simile, metaphor, hyperbole, allusion, imagery





Analogy- an extended comparison of two things that are alike in some way.

Syntax- the way words are put together to form phrases and sentences. Syntax can describe the length of the sentence and the use of formal and informal grammar.
